Only up to six papers are accepted for presentation to allow for in-depth discussion by the discussant assigned to each paper as well as sufficient room for interaction with the audience. The conference atmosphere also supports networking.

Travel grants are 400 euros for Europe and 1,000 euros for outside Europe.
